		<b>First Year Inquiry:</b> <b>FYI</b> 101, 102, 103 or <b>HONR</b> 101, 102, 103 (Foundations) or <b>HONR</b> 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126 or 127 (Logos) In the unlikely event that a student still needs to pass 101, 102 or 103 as a sophomore or above can substitute for the trimester based 101; the semester based 102 will substitute for either a trimester based 102 or 103.
		<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Language:</b> A year-long sequence of a given 2 <sup>nd</sup> Language is required. 101, 102, 103 for trimesters and 101, 102 for semesters. Students can also complete this requirement via established equivalency policies.
